The SCIENCE SLAM offers a platform for young research talents to showcase their work outside of the formal constraints of a research lab or class room. Each slammer will be judged on the basis of his/her ability to capture the audiences' attention with a precise, accessible and original introduction to their research topic. In 2015, EURAXEES team contributed to the 3 events of Science Slam Moldova contest: On the 28 May, the 8 October and the 8 December 2015 supporting the organisation, the preselection of the slammers and the prize awards. More than 250 people per Slam attended and voted for the 4 finalists.

On January 28, 2014 the finals of the Science SLAM Moldova will be held 2016. The best 4 Moldovan slammers will battle it out at the Odeon cinema starting from 18:00, bringing forward topics like *How robotics and 3D printing are changing our future? What functioning mechanisms do the microalgae and cyanobacteria's have? How did the contagious diseases impact the interwar Bessarabia? Why are the Moldovans aggressive?*
